

Deer Farm / Animal Health Technician

Full & Part Time Positions Available

M3 Whitetails

This position is primarily responsible for the care and feeding of the deer in our whitetail breeding facility. Successful candidate must have a keen eye and concern for details pertaining to animal condition and health, how they look and feel, and changes in behavior which might indicate changing health needs.

Primary duties will involve daily care of the deer population. This includes observing, feeding and medicating whitetail deer as well as bottle feeding fawns June-Sept. Feeding includes putting out 100 plus 50 pound bags of feed per week, putting out hay rain or shine, maintenance of feeders, and water systems and misting system.

Additional duties will include working with adult and fawn whitetail deer (moving, handling, tagging, capture (darting), transportation, routine veterinary care, assist with AI operations, photographing animals and editing pictures, etc.), maintenance of holding pens, barn, fences, gates, feeders, and water systems, working with exotic wildlife (blackbuck antelope, fallow deer, etc.), helping with system maintenance on mister system to help control flies and midges, help with manual treatment of deer pens to control flies and midges and predator control if necessary.

Most work will be outdoors and successful candidate will be expected to perform their duties in all kinds of weather and weather conditions. Successful candidate must be aware of and sensitive to conditions early on as they start to develop, must be a self starter, computer literate, detail oriented individual with a good attitude, able to follow instructions and get along with others.

Normal work week: Full Time and Part Time positions available. 20 – 60+ hours per week. Specific work schedule to be determined based on candidates availability and abilities. This job is not for an applicant looking for a paycheck, rather it is for a person who loves animals and the outdoors and wants to work where they can be paid to do what they love.
